Action taken Report on 2nd SLEC meeting held on 23.02.2015

The SLEC, SHM has noted the action taken on the decisions in the previous SLEC meeting held on 23.02.2015.

Approval of Annual Action Plan 2015-16 of SHM Telangana State.

Approved.

The SLEC has suggested to discourage Banana plantation as they require more water and are not suitable for Telangana State and also restrict the number of Pack houses in proportion to the existing horticulture area. The SHM cell should ensure that the Field Consultants hired on outsourcing basis belong to Telangana State.

Postharvest Management - Proposals for establishment of Cold Storages (8) Nos, Ripening Chambers (3) Nos and Reefer Vans (3) Nos.

Approved and permitted to submit to MIDH, GoI. The SLEC directed that the beneficiaries should not be retired Government employees or scientists or their spouses. In case of reefer vans it should be ascertained as to whether it is being used for fresh fruits and vegetables and whether the beneficiary is genuine, self employed person.

Approved and permitted to submit to MIDH, GoI for release of funds.

Protected Cultivation – List of farmers applied for establishment of Poly houses (9) Nos.






Mission Management Expenditure (01.02.2015 to 28.02.2015).
